LENT

Ash Wednesday

*_It is immediately preceded by Shrove Tuesday. Ash Wednesday is a solemn reminder of human mortality and the need for reconciliation with God and marks the beginning of the penitential Lenten season. It is commonly observed with the distribution of ashes and with fasting.

*Ash Wednesday marks the start of a 40-day period which is an allusion to the separation of Jesus in the desert to fast and pray. During this time he was tempted. Matthew 4:1–11, Mark 1:12–13, and Luke 4:1–13.

*Although the holiday of Ash Wednesday is **never directly mentioned in the Bible**, it is one of the most celebrated Christian events in church history. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-day season of fasting, reflection, and remembrance before the Holy Week and the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday.





St Patrick's Day – March 17

March 17, the day St. Patrick died

St. Patrick's Day celebrates the life and death of St. Patrick, Ireland's patron saint, and the arrival of Christianity in Ireland. It's also a day to celebrate Irish culture.


<u>What is Saint Patrick's famous quote?</u> He who believes shall be saved, but he who does not believe shall be damned.
